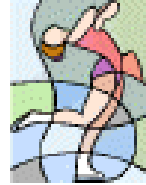

The MFSC Board will select ten (10) soloists. Skaters must have passed Pre-Preliminary MIF test to be eligible. Evaluation period is February 1, 2009- January 31, 2010. Skaters will be evaluated on points earned, their family's volunteer efforts and a narrative of why they want a solo. Skaters' applications will be evaluated as "the whole package" so earning the most points won't automatically secure the skater a solo as in years past. In order to be considered for a solo, skaters MUST COMPLETE this Showcase on Ice Solo Application Form.

Points can be earned in the following ways:

- 1 point for every 5 club ice sessions skated (tracked by MFSC)
- 1 point for participating in Fair Fundraiser (tracked by skater)
- 1 point for participating in Skate-a-Thon (tracked by skater)
- 1 point for each competition attended – maximum of 3 (tracked by skater)
- 1 point for each Regional, Sectional or National competition attended (tracked by skater)
- 1 point for each USFS test passed (tracked by skater)
- 1 point for each 50/50 fundraiser worked at a Mauler's Hockey Game (tracked by skater)

Hi Everyone,

After much consideration of skater, parent, coach, and volunteer feedback the MFSC Board has adopted the criteria and process of selecting solos for the 2009 Showcase On Ice.

Here's the information you need to know:

1. The MFSC Board & the Showcase On Ice Director(s) will select the soloists.
2. 10 solos will be awarded
3. Skaters must have passed Pre-Preliminary Moves in the Field test to be eligible
4. Evaluation period is February 1, 2008 to January 31, 2009.
3. Skaters will be evaluated on a points earned, their and their family's volunteer efforts, and a narrative of why they want a solo. Skaters' applications will be evaluated as "the whole package" so earning the most points won't automatically secure the skater a solo this year.
4. Skaters must complete a Showcase On Ice Solo Application Form that asks them to summarize their points, volunteer efforts and explain why they want a solo.
5. Points can be earned in the following ways:

1 point for every 5 club ice sessions skated (tracked by MFSC)

1 point for participating in Fair Fundraiser (tracked by skater)

1 point for participating in Skate-a-thon (tracked by skater)

1 point for each competition attended - maximum of 3 (tracked by skater)

1 point for each Regional, Sectional or National competition attended (tracked by Skater)

1 point for each USFS test passed (tracked by skater)

1 point for each 50/50 fundraiser worked at a Maulers Hockey Game (tracked by skater)

6. Volunteer efforts can include a variety of activities throughout the year. A list of events, programs and other activities will be sent out soon for your review. You can volunteer to chair an activity or to help a chairperson if they need assistance.

EXAMPLE: As an example, our first event of the season is the Western Montana Fair on August 5-10. The event entails three main activities: garbage pickup, MFSC info table during public skates, and a skating exhibition on Friday.

Skaters who participate in the fair garbage pickup fundraiser earn 1 point for Showcase and also earn 1 free hour of ice time.

Skaters/parents who staff the information table can use this on their Showcase Solo Application form as an additional volunteer activity. Be sure to specify how many hours you worked. The skating exhibition is free to skaters and also provides other volunteer opportunities, such as putting the master CD together, playing music, announcing the skaters, doing a simple brochure, and putting the skating order together.
