IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Costumes** Costumes will be distributed on Saturday, May 1st and Sunday, May 2nd, at the rink. Please plan to arrive at least 30 minutes early to your practice in order to get costume. Please make any adjustments before dress rehearsal (see below).
- Skating Tights** All skaters are required to provide their own skating tights under their costume unless your costume is pants. Please buy the "in the boot" style, not "over the boot" so all skaters are similar. Tights can be bought and/or ordered through Maulers Hockey Central in the Mall. They carry all other figure skating apparel and accessories.
- Dress Rehearsal** **Sunday, May 2nd - 3:00-5:45pm @ Glacier Ice Rink.** Plan on being there the entire time.
- 3:00-5:15pm:** Run-through the show. Groups and soloists will take pictures after.
5:15-5:30pm: Finale practice for **ALL** participants. Please stick around.
5:30-5:45pm: Club Photo. Club members, please wear your blue club jacket.
- Please bring safety pins and arrive 30 minutes early. Be ready to go at any minute. All skaters have purchased their costumes so should take them home after Dress Rehearsal. Please do not allow your child to wear their costume for "play" until after the show. All costumes should be intact and clean for the show.
- Show Photos** MFSC Soloist, Basic Skills group number, and Club group number photos will be taken during Dress Rehearsal on Sunday, May 2nd from 3:00p.m.-5:45 p.m. (See attached order forms). The Club Member Photo will be taken at from 5.30-5.45pm at Dress Rehearsal. Soloists should wear the costume they plan on wearing in the show.
- Gifts for Skaters** MFSC will be selling stuffed animals at the show for spectators to throw onto the ice after their favorite performances. \$5-10 each
